I take the present opportunity to answer your letter which we received yesterday evening glad to hear you both are well and are enjoying eating so much i guess when you come back you can't eat we are goin to make efforts to feed you well we had a meal of rosmaries for dinner it was splendid you and Mary ought to bin here to have mess w. tea right smart yet if the frost don't come to soon. we are getting ready for seedin & don't know yet when we will begin the boys are cutting off corn it is blowed down very much. the corn is very heavy the boys were just in here Howard said I shud tell you that you shud send that buck eye girl right along

she wants her to help to cut off corn. the  
boy said your corn in they tomato patch  
has the largest grains that they ever seen.  
We just brought 5 of your daddie beans in &  
am thinking you won't have beans enough  
for seed we haven dug your potato out in  
the field yet we have dug all of our sweet  
potato we made about 30 bushels. we live of  
our chickens & sweet potato & 80s ears & Water  
melons know when you come back we  
are going to live on sourcrot & turnips  
our haggards is even living high now. the have  
I mutton & tomatoes know your lamb that pa  
que you is dead it got so it coudnt walk.  
we have 20 the prettiest pigs you ever seen.  
dock is getting so fractious she cannot hardly hold  
she will be your master until you come back  
Marietta Huffer said he goes better than bell or rose  
she was down last week it rained and we  
took her home

how old Maryland is getting along I believe it is alive and kicking as far as I know we have beautiful weather this last week and far the water melon that one is eaten we have two in the spring house know Howard and I eat a splendid one yesterday we wished for you we are going to try and keep one for you the are very nice ones here yet and if we can't keep none for you we will have some peanuts for you and your cat I think you would better bring a pair so you can have the western bread of cats tie one to your dress tail and one to ~~the~~ coat tail What a nice time you will have coming home the sail you shoud bring him off you can bring me 2 or 3 bushels of eye toys along so I can get good one & ~~get~~ a good one & hear to find out there

ma said you shud dress thick so you woudnt  
get chills. She is very fraid her babies will  
get sick. While you are gone I must stop  
writting for this time my sen is so bad  
that I can harly do anything with it is.  
nothing but a post hole diger Write soon

ous all well except ma she is about like  
was right smart complainig some times
