In reply to your indorsement of June 18, 1907, on the request of the Attorney General, for information in the above-entitled cause, pending in the Court of Claims, I have the honor to inform you that the accounts of Capt. John McHarg, A.Q.M., show payment was made to the above named church, as follows:

"For damages sustained by the Evangelical Reformed Church at Burkittsville, Md., and in the Qr. Mrs. Dept. at Frederick, Md., used as hospital for sick and wounded soldiers from September 14, 1862, to January 31, 1863, 4 months and 17 days" - - - - - \$351.50, as per Voucher 155, Abst. B, for August, 1863.
